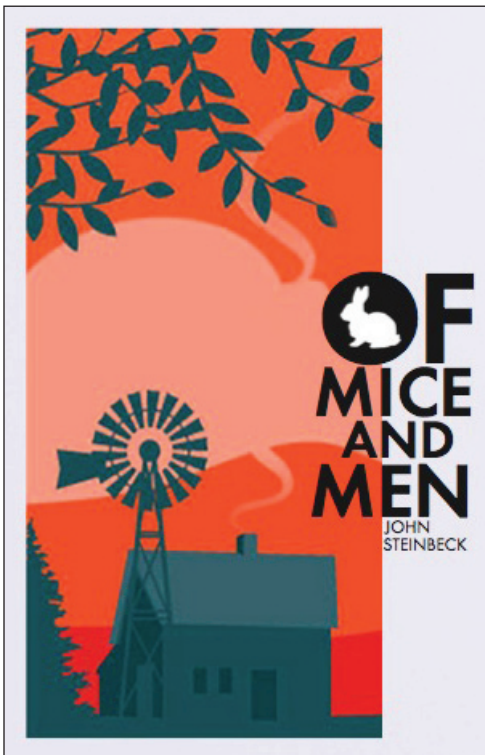


Thinking points:
